Pineapple Fruit Cake.

2oz Halved Cherries 7oz. Self-Raising Flour 5oz Soft Margarine 2 eggs beaten 12oz Mixed Dried Fruit 2 Tablespoons Milk 8oz Can of Pineapple Pieces (Drained) 5oz Light soft Brown Sugar Method:

- 1. Grease and line an 8" round cake tin with greaseproof paper,
- 2. Roll the halved cherries in a little flour and finely chop drained pineapple.
- 3. Cream the margarine and sugar gradually beating in the eggs.
- Then gently fold in the flour milk dried fruit Cherries and Pineapple
- 5. Pour mixture into prepared tin and smooth the top. Bake in a moderate oven 160°c 325°f Gas Mark 3 for about 2 hours until the cake is pale golden brown and shrinking from the sides of the tin.
- 6. Leave in the tin until cold before turning out.
- 7. Store in the fridge rather than a tin because this is a very moist cake. Eat within 6 weeks.
