Banana Nut Bread.

225 gm/8oz	Self-Raising Flour	75gm/3oz Golder S	yrup
50gm/2oz	Margarine	1 Egg	
50gm/2oz	Caster Sugar	2 Bananas 🛛 👗	
25gm/1oz	Walnuts + chopped	Milk to mix 🛛 🗮	

Grease and line the base of a small loaf tin. Put flour in a bowl and rub in margarine. Add the sugar and walnuts. Mash the bananas in a basin. Beat in the egg and add the syrup. Pour into dry ingredients and mix well adding enough milk to make a soft consistency. Pour into tin and bake at 180°/350°/Mark 4 for one hour. Store for at least 24 hours before slicing and buttering. **To be exhibited uncut.**
