### Coffee and Walnut Cake

225g/8oz unsalted butter      3 Tablespoons Strong Fresh Black Coffee

225g/8oz caster sugar      225g/8oz self - raising flour

4 eggs      50g /2oz finely chopped walnuts

#### Method

- Preheat oven to 180C / 350F/ Gas 4
- Cut and soften butter and beat together with the sugar until light and pale.
- Add the eggs one at a time into the mixture beating well before adding the next egg.
- Add the strong coffee to the mixture stirring well adding flour and walnuts, don't allow to curdle.
- Spoon mixture into two lined and greased cake tins. The cake tins can be either 20cm/8" or 17.5cm/ 7"
- Bake for 25-30 minutes
- Fill with you own recipe and flavour of butter cream
- The top of the cake can be decorated as you wish.

# Rules and Conditions

1. Entries in all sections are open to everyone, including children. Exhibitors must all be **AMATEURS**.
2. Any objection raised as to the qualification of an exhibitor shall be dealt with by the Flower Show Committee and its decision shall be final.
3. **All Pot Plants** must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least **Six months**, All other exhibits for at least two months, except in the Domestic Section and where stated.
4. **All entries** should be submitted on the relevant entry forms. Entries for the **Spring Show** will only be accepted on the day of the show from 9 am to 10.30 am. Entry forms for the **Summer Show** should be submitted to the Flower Show Secretary, not later than 3 pm on **Friday 4th August 2017**. Entries will be accepted on the day of the show **but the entry fee will then be 30p** and must be staged by 10.30 am.
5. Entry fees will be 20p for all classes.
6. The Hall will be open from 9-00 a.m. to 10-30 a.m. and **no entries will be accepted after this time.**
7. One entry per person in any one class.
8. Exhibits are not to be removed from the tables before the Prize-giving at 16.00.
9. The Flower Show Committee will not be held responsible for any damage that may occur to the exhibits.
10. All cup winners to hold trophy for **eleven months**. All cups **must** be returned to the Show Secretary **one month** before the Show.
11. Prizes : 1st - 30p 2nd - 25p 3rd - 20p.
12. The judges are empowered to withhold any award at their discretion.

## Marble Cake

|--------------------------------------|-------------------------------|
| 225g (8oz) margarine or butter       | 225g (8oz) Self raising flour |
| 225g (8oz) caster sugar              | 4 eggs beaten                 |
| 3 colours and flavours of own choice |                               |

### Method

- Grease and line an 18cm (7") round cake tin with greaseproof paper.
- Cream the margarine /butter with sugar - gradually beating in the eggs.
- Then gently fold in the sifted flour .
- Divide mixture into 3 bowls, colour and flavour as desired.
- Pour mixture into greased tin. Using a skewer, swirl mixture round to slightly mix colours.
- Bake in a preheated oven 180°C 350°F Gas Mark 4 for about 1 – 1¼ hours until well risen and spongy to touch.
